Sylvia was a 1940 graduate of Oshkosh High School. She went on to cosmetology school in Appleton and worked for several years at Martha Manning's Beauty Shop in Oshkosh. On November 7, 1947, Sylvia married Lester C. Laedtke at First English Lutheran Church in Oshkosh. For thirty years Sylvia made many women feel beautiful in the Larsen-Winchester area as the owner and operator of Sylvia's Style Studio. Sylvia had a life long relationship with the Lord. She was baptized, confirmed, and married at First English Lutheran Church; was a member of Grace Lutheran Church of Winchester for over 40 years and became a member of Midvale Community Lutheran Church when she and Lester moved to Madison in 2007.
