Carl H. Liermann, age 88, of Larsen, was called to his eternal home on Monday, April 23, 2012, and 2 days later, on April 25, 2012, Myrtle joined Carl in heaven.

Carl was born July 6, 1923, in Kewaskum, to the late A. Paul and Sadie (Bleck) Liermann. On October 4, 1921, Myrtle was born to the late Arthur and Rosa (Gessner) Glander. On June 22, 1946 they were united in marriage in Sheboygan County. For 17 years Carl and Myrtle farmed in Random Lake until 1964, at which time they bought a farm in Winneconne, where they farmed for 13 years until moving to Larsen. In 1964, Carl and Myrtle received the Farmer of the Year Award for their efforts in soil conservation. Carl and Myrtle enjoyed square dancing, card club, and Myrtle had been a member of the East Winneconne Homemakers Club, and served as a 4-H leader. They were active members of Winneconne Christian Fellowship.
