Mildred Millard passed away unexpectedly with her family by her side on Thursday, December 5, 2013, at Ministry Saint Michael's Hospital in Stevens Point. She worked in Clintonville and Oshkosh until August of 1940 when she married Hayward Millard. They moved to Minneapolis, Minnesota in 1941, returning to Oshkosh in 1944. For many, many years Mildred and Hayward farmed in the Hortonville and Winchester areas until their retirement in 1990, at which time they moved to Neenah. Mildred was actively involved in the quilt group in both congregations and over the years she is responsible for pressing thousands of quilts made and donated for church missions.
