Rodney G. Williams, age 75, died Monday, October 20, 2014, after a well-fought battle with cancer. He was born January 9, 1939, in Oshkosh to Harvey and Pearl (Courtney) Williams. Rodney attended Winneconne High School and the University of Wisconsin-Oshkosh, completing a science degree during his subsequent service in the United States Navy. After his service, Rodney worked for Winnebago County Social Services until he retired to Lakehills, Texas. Rodney's passion to his country was only matched by his passion for Harley Davidson motorcycles. When not riding, he was a voracious reader of history, politics, science, religion, electronics, technology, and science fiction. Surviving Rodney are his siblings, Walter Williams, Peggy (Larry) Hirschberg, Debra (Jeffrey) Becker; and nephews, Jeffrey Hirschberg, Jason (Susan) Hirschberg, and Brian Meyer.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Harvey and Pearl (Courtney) Williams.
