Theresa "Terry" C. (Buyeske) Fahley, age 81, of Winneconne, peacefully went to be with her Lord, on Tuesday, November 10, 2009, after a short battle with cancer.

She was born on December 21, 1927 on a farm in Gresham, Wisconsin, the youngest daughter of thirteen children born to Joseph and Theresa (Weber) Stoehr. Terry worked for the T.C.
