Earl G. Thull, age 85, of Winneconne, passed away Sunday, February 14, 2010, with his family at his side. Earl proudly served his country as a World War II veteran in the U.S. Navy on the USS Bouganville. He was awarded the World War II Victory Medal, American Area Campaign, Asiatic-Pacific Bronze Star, and the American Theatre. On April 19, 1947, he married the former Alice Louise Krueger at St. Mary Catholic Church in Winneconne with Rev. Victor Kaudy as celebrant. Earl worked as an independent truck driver, and at the Winnebago County Farmco Cooperative. He was a member of St. Mary Catholic Church, and the American Legion Post 364 of Winneconne. Earl enjoyed traveling around the United States, wintering in Florida, boating, hunting, and fishing. You could always find Earl on his garden tractor blowing snow in the winter and mowing lawn in the summer. He loved it so much; he even blew the neighbors' driveways and mowed their lawns. Earl had a passion for spending time with his family and friends, and especially dearly loving his wife Alice to whom he was extremely devoted.

In addition to his wife of 62 years, Earl is also survived by two children and their spouses; Sherry and Roger Rozek, of Winneconne; Greg and Marie Thull, of Winneconne; five grandchildren; Nate and Carrie Rozek, of Madison; Allison (Rozek) Postell, and her husband Joe, of Alexandria, Virginia; Jeremy Thull, Clint Thull, Kristine Thull, all of Winneconne; one great-grandchild; Carter Pongratz-Thull.
