Ardell Annette Peters, age 68, peacefully entered into eternal rest at her home on July 4, 2009, after a courageous battle with cancer, with her family at her side. She was born January 20, 1941, the daughter of the late Edward and Frieda (Kislewski) Gavinski.

She attended St. John's Grade School and was a graduate of Menasha High School class of 1959. After graduating, Ardell was employed as a secretary to the Director of the Menasha Vocational School until her marriage to Robert J. Peters on June 15, 1963.
