Marshall John Proehl, age 79, of Oshkosh, died Sunday, March 12, 2023, at home. He was born February 17, 1944, in Milwaukee to Dr. Frederick and Ruth (Lauterbach) Proehl. Marshall earned a Bachelor's Degree in Sociology from Lakeland College. Marshall served his country in the U.S Marine Corps., serving in Vietnam from 1966 until 1968, and was honorably discharged in 1972. On November 1, 1969, Marsh married Dorothy Little in Fond du Lac. In 2009 he retired from the Winneconne Community School District. He enjoyed fishing, hunting, woodworking, and spending time with his grandchildren.
