Rose Ann (Sutter) Luce, age 90 in body, forever young in mind and heart, ended her journey on Friday, September 15, 2023. She had an interesting childhood growing up on a farm and attended a one room schoolhouse for eight years; she then attended Winneconne High School and graduated in 1951.
