Wallace "Wally" Waters, age 76, of Winneconne, died Thursday, April 8, 2010, at Froedtert Hospital in Milwaukee. He was born November 23, 1933, in Oconomowoc to the late Harry and Norma (Labs) Waters. Wally served his country with the U.S. Army during the Korean War, and following his active duty, he served in the Army Reserves.
